- Internet access or magazines (for inspiration)



What does a Costume Designer do? A Costume Designer supports the story the director wants to tell through what the characters wear on stage. To decide what each character will wear, the Costume Designer first reads the play to understand the story. Then Costume Designer will draw or create ideas for what each character will wear (sometimes, these are called renderings).

Try creating your own character and design a costume for them!

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Using the provided adjective list on the next page, pick 3-4 adjectives that will describe your character. You can also pick 3-4 adjectives of your own.
- 2. Write a biography about a new character that matches the adjectives you chose. Some things to consider: What is this person's name? What do they do? Are they a student? What do they do for fun? Where does this person live? Do they exist in the past, present, or future? Is this someone you could meet in real life, or from a fantasy world?
- 3. Using all of your notes, create a costume for your character! You can collect images you find online or in magazines around your home for inspiration. Look for different kinds of outfits and pieces of clothing that you think this character should wear. When you're ready, draw what the costume would look like on your character.

Take your original adjectives, choose opposite words, and design the opposite character!
